



EFL Plus Hairdressing and Beauty

Who is the course for?

This course is designed for overseas students who wish to enter the field of Hairdressing and Beauty. This full-time programme involves 21 hours of study per week. The amount of English and subject courses will depend on the choice of subject and the student's level of English. Students may enrol in September, January or April. Please contact us for more details about this.

Entry Requirements

You need to have an intermediate level of English or IELTS Band 4.5 or a TOEFL score of 400

What do the courses consist of?

English as a Foreign Language - General English

We have classes at a range of levels. We will test you on your arrival at the College so we can put you in a class at the appropriate level. All students enrolled on our courses may take an examination in December or June.

Examinations taken include:

- IELTS
- Cambridge First Certificate
- Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English

Hairdressing and Beauty course

The course covers the theoretical and practical aspects of both Hairdressing and Beauty.

Beauty

- Manicure/Pedicure - Theory and practice of treatments for the hands and feet. Certificate in Nail Art
- Aromatherapy and Indian Head Massage
- Intensive Stone Therapy
- Epilation & Threading. Waxing
- Eye Treatments - eyebrow shaping and eyelash tinting treatments
- Fashion/photographic make up

Hairdressing

You will cover a number of practical units including:

- Shampoo/Conditioning and Blow Dry Hair
- Perming and Colouring Processes
- General Reception Duties
- Health and Safety
- Basic Cutting Skills

Optional subjects - Foreign Languages

You may choose to study a foreign language as part of your course. Those on offer are French, Italian, and Spanish.

Qualifications

This course leads to a number of qualifications in both Hairdressing and Beauty and English as a Foreign Language.

What can I do next?

Once you have completed the course you will have the opportunity to study at an advanced level and specialise in other Beauty subjects such as:

- Aromatherapy
- Body Massage
- False Nails - application of artificial nail structures

Fees: £4400

The fees include an EFL examination fee in December or June.

You should allow at least £500 for specialist Hairdressing and Beauty examination fees and equipment and also for coursebooks.
