

## Motorcycle Maintenance and Repair Level 2

This course is designed for ages 16-19 and 19+ adults.

Our IMI Diploma in Motorcycle Maintenance and Repair Principles (QCF) Level 2 course is designed to provide you with the knowledge and skills to access the Motor Vehicle Industry. Once you have completed your hands-on mechanics training, you will be industry ready.

Throughout the course you will be trained and assessed to achieve an IMI qualification. You will also receive training which reflects the reality of the industry and will provide you with a comprehensive understanding of the skills and knowledge required to progress your career.

The course is scheduled over 3 days per week and will be a mixture of theory and practical across the 2 years.

### Progression opportunities

This course will lead to:

- Employment – This qualification will give you the skills required to gain employment.

### Entry Requirements

The entry requirements for this course are:

- You must have completed Year 1 of the course
- Must have achieved both maths and English GCSEs to at least grade 4.
- A science GCSE is also preferred.

### What will I study?

This course consists of the following modules:

- Health and Safety / tool identification
- Motorcycle construction and routine maintenance
- Operating principles of motorcycle engines
- Brakes, tyres and suspension systems
- Electrical and Electronic systems
