The AAT Level 3 Advanced Certificate In Bookkeeping qualification will allow you to pursue a career in finance and accounting.

You may have completed the Foundation Certificate in Accounting, be currently working in the financial sector or looking to re-train and develop your accounting skills. This course will introduce you to more complex accounting tasks such as maintaining cost accounting records and the preparation of reports and returns.
