Progression opportunities

This course will lead to a Level 3 programme which is seen by industry employers as a professional status. It is focussed on producing highly proficient, occupationally competent, professional Beauty Therapists that can perform a wide variety of treatments and services and are job ready.

Entry Requirements

The entry requirements for this course are:

- You will be required to attend an informal interview which may include completing an assessment based on your prior qualifications

What will I study?

This course consists of the following modules:

- Provide facial skin care
- Provide eyelash and eyebrow treatments
- Remove hair using waxing techniques
- Provide manicure treatments
- Provide pedicure treatments
- Apply make-up

How will I be assessed?

- Portfolios of collated study evidence
- In addition to timetabled classes there is provision for independent study time. Students will undertake independent learning, investigation and research and bring this to present and share in subsequent classes

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
