The Level 1 Certificate in Introduction to Health, Social Care and Children's and Young People's Settings aims to develop learners' knowledge and awareness of health, social care and children's and young people's settings.

It is aimed at learners in school or college who wish to develop an understanding of the similarities and differences between these settings. It is especially for those learners that wish to work in Care but are not sure of which sector.
