

Project Search Level 1

This course is designed for young people aged 16-18, or up to 24 with an EHCP who have Special Education Needs and/or a Learning Difficulty.

DFN Project SEARCH is a supported internship programme that prepares young people with learning disabilities, autism and/or sensory impairment for competitive employment.

Each year, Whipps Cross Hospital and St. Bartholomew's Hospital, gives young people the chance to learn valuable job-related skills as an intern. The programme is unpaid and based full-time in the hospital workplace.

Learners who are interested in this course must:

- Have a desire to work
- Be committed to attending Project SEARCH every day
- Be seeking paid employment as a goal

Following a Barts Health NHS Trust induction, interns complete three 10-week rotations across different departments allowing them the opportunity to try different job roles and to build up a range of transferable skills in readiness for a job application.
