What will I study?

Independence Pathway

Entry Level 1 BTEC Personal Progress Qualification Award, Certificate and Diploma size qualification. 1-3 years (dependent upon progress)

Targeted at students wishing to continue in education who are currently functioning academically at Pre-entry to Entry Level 1.

This course is at Entry Level 1 and consists of the following modules:

- Cooking techniques
- Gardening
- Sports
- Money management
