Already working within a school as a Teaching Assistant
Level 2 or equivalent in maths and English

You will be required to attend an informal interview which may include completing an assessment based on your prior qualifications.

- Child development and well-being
- Supporting children and young people with special educational needs (SEN)
- Promoting children and young people's positive behaviour
- Working with individuals and groups of learners
- Positive working relationships
