

## Award in Education and Training

This course is designed for 19+ Adults who wish to work in the lifelong learning sector as a teacher, trainer or associate teacher or technician. This course will form part of the DTLLS (Diploma in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector). It may be taken as a separate course.

### Entry Requirements

The entry requirements for this course are:

- A Level 3 qualification and/or relevant experience in the subject you intend to teach
- Minimum Level 2 literacy and numeracy or equivalent
- You will be required to attend an informal interview which may include completing an assessment based on your prior qualifications

### What will I study?

The course consists of the following modules:

- The role of the tutor and the interrelationships with other professionals
- Referral systems
- The characteristics and aspirations of the adult learner
- Methods and resources used in adult classes

### How will I be assessed?
