This course is designed for 19+ Adults who would like to work or already work in a primary or secondary school, as a teaching or learning support assistant and who are seeking professional accreditation for their specialist skills.

Entry Requirements

The entry requirements for this course are:

- Finding work placement in a school for a minimum of one day per week for the whole year on a voluntary basis, if you are not already working in a school.
- You also need to have a DBS enhanced disclosure
- You will be required to attend an informal interview which may include an assessment based on your prior qualifications
