- Finding work placement in a school for a minimum of one day per week for the whole year on a voluntary basis (if you are not already working in a school)
- You also need to have a DBS enhanced disclosure
- You will be required to attend an informal interview which may include an assessment based on your prior qualifications

- Presentations
