

Travel & Tourism Level 3

The NCFE Level 3 Introductory Diploma in Travel and Tourism is designed to give learners the skills to work in the Travel & Tourism Industry. The qualification will also enable progression to further studies.

This programme will focus on the study of the Travel & Tourism Industry in several occupational areas, offer breadth and depth of study, incorporate a key core of knowledge, skills and understanding, and provide opportunities to acquire a number of practical and work-related skills.

Waltham Forest College is putting sustainability at the heart of everything that we do, and in this course, you will learn more about sustainable tourism and how the industry works to be eco-friendly, for example, through responsible travel, ecotourism and looking to reduce the carbon footprint.

The course is scheduled for 3-4 days per week.

Tourism in the UK is a vital source of economic activity, contributing to Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and supporting jobs across the UK through a mix of inbound, outbound and domestic tourism.

The sector is made up of other sub-sectors including, airlines, airports, hotels, tour operators, travel agency, visitor attractions and ancillary services. It is expected that the Travel & Tourism Industry will add 126 million new job opportunities between 2022 and 2032.
